Fidelity Charitable's population of Miami donors grew considerably in 2018, with a 20 percent year-over-year increase in Giving Accounts. That rise was accompanied by significant grantmaking activity, with Miami-area donors recommending nearly \$68 million in grants to charity, at an average of almost 12 grants per Giving Account®. Miami's diverse population creates an interesting mix of charitable priorities—with human services, education and health receiving the most support from the area.

Highlights in Miami giving



Giving here goes everywhere

Miami is a melting pot with a large population of residents from other places—both national and international—creating a broad mix of philanthropic interests and priorities that go beyond donors' backyards. More than half of metropolitan-area residents speak a language other than English¹—reflecting the diverse histories of the residents that make up the area's population. With their more global worldview, Miami's donors supported national and international organizations with nearly three-quarters of their grant dollars in 2018.

Miami in the rankings

The Miami area appears on top 10 lists for giving to three of the eight giving sectors. The region tops the society benefit sector list and comes in third for the health sector. Miami also made its debut on the international affairs list, at ninth place.

Diverse local support

Five of the eight charitable sectors are represented on Miami's list of top local nonprofits, demonstrating donors' commitment to all aspects of community life—from the region's top hospitals to its public television and radio stations.

GIVING SECTOR SPOTLIGHT

Society benefit

Forty-nine percent of Giving Accounts in the Miami metro area supported society benefit charities in 2018—including organizations working in civil rights, volunteerism and social advocacy. This show of support placed the region at the top of the sector rankings.

Nearly one in ten of Miami's six million residents identify as Jewish.² This significant population drives strong support of various organizations based in the Jewish faith, including local chapters of the Jewish Federation that took the top two spots on the list of popular local nonprofits.
